# Double Shoe Farm Casper, Wyoming Swine Scholarship 2018

This scholarship is designed to promote interaction between the leaders of today and those of tomorrow by providing 4-H/FFA member's a quality show pig for their county fair, as well as gain a depth of knowledge about the swine industry from the breeder. It is the goal of the show pig scholarship to assist junior members with strong scholastic skills, who may not be financially able to purchase a show pig.

The scholarship recipient responsibilities are as follows:

- Complete the required amount of community service hours needed for award (8-11yrs min of 10hrs; 12yrs+ min of 15hrs)
- Assume responsibility of all production expenses Incurred (feed, vet fees, etc.,)
- Responsible for transportation of pig from Double Shoe Farm.
- Submit monthly status reports to Double Shoe Farm. Status reports are to include updates on hog performance, jackpot shows entered, etc.

Application Deadline: January 15, 2018. Late or incomplete applications will be not be considered.

• The top 10 chosen applicants will be selected for an in-person interview and will be notified by February 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018. Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018.
